Dear Senator Schatz,

I am deeply concerned about the ongoing epidemic of sexual violence against Indigenous women in the United States. Over half of them have experienced sexual violence.

Nearly 1 in 3 have experienced rape in their lifetime. The USA has an obligation to protect, respect, and fulfill the human rights of Indigenous women, and it must act swiftly to address this crisis of sexual violence.

I urge you to advocate for the US-Government to:

- implement legislation that recognizes the jurisdiction of tribal authorities over all crimes committed on tribal land, regardless of the tribal citizenship of the accused,
- Make available long-term, predictable and adequate funding for tribal law enforcement, justice services and culturally appropriate support services,
- Ensures all Indigenous survivors receive comprehensive reproductive health care and timely and adequate post-rape care.
