Frauen benötigen zur Aufnahme einer Arbeit die Zustimmung ihres Mannes oder Vaters.




Eine Zeugenaussage einer Frau vor Gericht zählt halb so viel wie die eines Mannes.




Frauen dürfen nicht öffentlich als Solistinnen singen.



Staatliche Reaktionen auf die Proteste



Demonstrierende werden getötet oder schwer verletzt.



Demonstrierende suchen sich bei Verletzungen keine Hilfe, aus Angst in einer Arztpraxis oder im Krankenhaus verhaftet zu werden.



Geständnisse werden unter Folter erzwungen.

Staatliche Reaktionen auf die Proteste



Familien werden massiv eingeschüchtert, damit sie nicht über das Schicksal ihrer verletzten oder getöteten Angehörigen berichten.



Ein neues Gesetz soll den Kopftuchzwang und die Geschlechtertrennung noch rigorosier durchsetzen.





Situation von Frauen in iranischen Gefängnissen

Revolutionary Guards agents arbitrarily arrested Maryam, a protester who removed her veil in public along with her friends, during protests. She was detained in solitary confinement in a Revolutionary Guards detention centre for nearly two months.




They started ripping my clothes. I was screaming and begging them to stop. In response to my pleadings, they p*nched me hard in my mouth [...] There were three of them, including the interrogator... They v***ently r*ped me. [...] After that I lost consciousness. I regained consciousness when they threw water on my head and shouted to others: "Come and take this f*ltthy sl*t".



They kept me in solitary confinement for weeks and gave me no medical care for my injuries, not even a tissue. No doctor ever came to see me. I suffered from bleeding and infection and had to use parts of my torn clothes for the bleeding. Whenever I asked them for medical care, they just mocked me. I did not think I was going to stay alive. [...] Their intention was to make us into the walking dead.





I met two other women who were brought to my cell for a period of time. They had also been r*ped [...] and had suffered injuries. When we shared our ordeals with each other, we could not stop crying. But, unlike me, they had not lost consciousness. They said they suffered horrific pressure. One of them tried to commit s**cide after her release.
